

TWO LUNCHTIME performances in the city today will serve as a taste of things to come in the Summer City programme to be centred on the Dell, behind the Begonia House in the Botanic Gardens, during January.

At 12.30pm a performing Baroque chamber music group(pictured above) will give a recital at Rotary Court on the corner of Mercer and Lower Cuba

Streets.

Group members Nigel Keay (violin), Rodney Ford (oboe), Mike Calvert (guitar) and Jenni Dodge (cello) have a basic Baroque repetoire but also play new music of their own composition and extant pieces. The type of music they specialise in is ideally suited to confined settings in park venues.
