Concert salutes Nigel Keay's work

Composer Nigel Keay's music will feature in a free concert in the recital theatre of the Nelson School of Music on Sunday night.

Keay has been composer-in-residence at the School of Music for the last two years, and the concert will give the public a further opportunity to hear his work. Of the pieces being pre-

sented on Sunday, one is a premiere performance, and two others are first-time performances in Nelson.

The concert will be in two parts: the first half will be original concert works by Keay for various instrumental ensembles; the second half, to be performed by the Nelson String Quartet,

will comprise lighter music including arrangements made by the composer for the quartet.
